- Homeland Security \$
- Local-State split of 80/20
 - 67 sheriffs
 - 330+ police chiefs
- Law Enforcement Advisory Council
 - Must agree before any spending plan for LE-related is approved
- Ultimately, they unanimously agreed to allow ACJIC to do work for them with local \$


