ICAOS and SEARCH Partnership

- **2019 BJA JRI Grant Award: *Proactive Notification of Arrest Warrants Entered for Persons Under Supervision***
 - Subscription/Notifications on Warrants
 - Automated Entry into FBI Supervised Release File
- **Proof of Concept Approach**
- **Design anticipated FBI ORI Assignment to ICAOS**



State-by-State Deployments

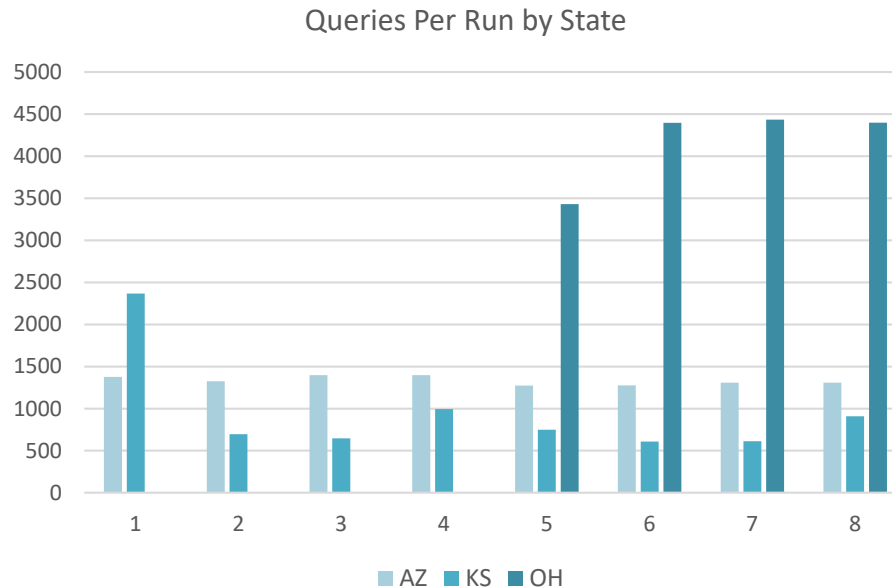
- **Impact:**
 - Management Control Agreements with each state
 - CJIS Background Checks for each state
 - Custom development code for each state
 - Network connectivity compliance for each state
- **Effect:**
 - Project extended from 2022 to 2024
 - Reduced goal of state participants

Metrics

	Arizona	Kansas	Ohio
Weekly Average Number of Queries	1324	948	4165
Weekly Average of Wanted Person Hits	52	48	338
Weekly Average of Notifications Generated	49	11	227

Arizona and Kansas query only received offenders.

Ohio queries both received and sent offenders





Partnership with Nlets

- **Secure connectivity with each state switch**
- **Provides audit compliance**
- **State Nlets Representatives**
 - Relationships
 - Familiarity with CJIS/NCIC
- **Network connectivity compliance for each state**
- **Method of utilizing existing ORIs**

State Expectations and Project Activities

- **Management Control Agreement**
- **Provide Access to Message Switch and IT Staff**
- **Facilitate Training with Supervising Officers**
- **User Testing and Acceptance**



Lessons Learned

- **Earlier and continual engagement of end-users in requirements**
- **State-by-state approach is costly, limits benefits and unsustainable to scale**
- **Engaging in the project was essential to prove the benefit to practitioners and demonstrate the usefulness of data sharing**
- **Modern technology and cooperative solutions created by states must be accommodated within CJIS policy and the architecture of national systems**
