7. If yes, what is the time period?	Time period determined by the requesting agency; there is no statutory requirement that the record is current to a particular time period.

Automated notification is being developed for specific purposes — foster home parents, for example. By statute, an agency may request an updated report at any time, provided it verifies that the record was originally released based on a fingerprint search, and a \$20 fee is paid.
